### **SPIRIT OF SUMUD**

Pilgrimage to Palestine

# Warm your heart, refresh your soul and meet new friends in Palestine.

We invite you to join a youth pilgrimage to Palestine. This youth pilgrimage will help you to seek communion with God but also to discover the Palestinian land – its colorful culture, the spirit of *sumud* (resilience), the dabkeh dance, and ecological diversity (picnic in the desert!). You will stay together with people from different countries at the friendly Betharram Monastery in the warm heart of Bethlehem.

# What makes this pilgrimage unique?

## You will:

- Travel on centuries-old paths that Jesus walked
- Engage with youth from different fascinating cultures
- Meet Palestinian families whose lifestyle is an emblem of sumud
- Experience incredibly friendly hospitality
- Share traditional, unknown cultural and spiritual customs as well as hands-on workshops
- Reflect upon real peace in the land associated with peace
- Observe present-day situations which you may know from the news, like the Separation Wall and a Palestinian refugee camp



### **PROGRAM**

You will explore the streets of **Bethlehem** center and visit the Church of Nativity, the traditional birthplace of Jesus. There will be a visit of Aida refugee camp and a walk along the 8-9 meter high Wall erected around Rachel's Tomb.

The Mount of Olives will show you a grand panorama of **Jerusalem**. We will walk downhill to Gethsemane, further into the Old City of Jerusalem, with its famous Via Dolorosa, Holy Sepulchre, Western Wall and Dome of the Rock.

In ancient **Hebron** we will visit the divided Cave of Machpela/Ibrahimi Mosque, and walk in the center and the suq, encountering local youth. On the way back a meeting at the Tent of Nations, a Palestinian agricultural and ecological project on a hill top south of Bethlehem, showing the deep human principles of sumud.

On a visit to **Bedouins** and the desert to the east of Bethlehem, you will learn how desert people take care of animals, and share a lunch with Bedouins. Of course, you will have a chance to float on the **Dead Sea**.

In **Jericho** you will visit desert monasteries, Nebi Musa (Moslem holy place), and the traditional Baptism place at the Jordan River. Plus the old city of Jericho, enjoying a glass of a cold fresh orange juice!

Back in **Bethlehem** there will be relaxed meetings with Palestinian youth about youth life, a picnic/barbecue in open nature, and music performances, topped off by the Palestinian dabkeh dance.

### **SUMUD**

Many citizens of Palestine have developed in their individual daily life the idea of *sumud*. Literally the Arabic word of *sumud* means 'steadfastness' or 'perseverance', but it is sometimes also translated as Palestinian 'resilience'.

### **NOTICE**

The program will sometimes start early in the morning or end in the evening to avoid the midday sun. AEI accompaniers will be present throughout the program to provide basic information about sites visited. The program may be adapted when the situation on the ground requires it.
